Tesco food supplements x4

Date of recall: 03/12/21

We're recalling 4 Tesco food supplements. This is because they've been found to contain 2-Chloroethonal, which is a recognised reaction product of ethylene oxide. Ethylene oxide is a pesticide that isn't permitted for use in food supplements sold in the EU but is approved for use by other countries outside the EU. Although taking the supplements doesn't pose an acute risk to health, there's an increased risk if they're taken over a long period of time.
