We understand that this news may cause concern and sincerely apologise for any inconvenience caused. Both medications are used to treat high blood pressure, however because your body may not be used to a different type of medicine, your blood pressure may become lower than normal, and you may experience dizziness as a result of taking amlodipine.

If you are unsure or have any questions, please seek advice from your pharmacy or other healthcare professionals responsible for your care. If you've already taken Amlodipine, please be reassured that there is a very low risk to your health.
