



IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- It is hazardous for anyone other than a competent person to carry out any service or repair operation that involves the removal of a cover which gives protection against exposure to electrical parts.


- Keep the appliance away from water; do not allow it to get wet. If unit is wet, do not plug unit into wall socket or turn unit on.
- Do not handle the appliance with wet hands.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close door on cord, pull cord around sharp corners or edges, or expose cord to heated surfaces. Do not unplug by pulling on cord.
- To protect against electrical shock do not immerse cord, plug, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Unplug from the mains outlet when not in use, before putting on and taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- Only use the unit when fully assembled.
- Never place your fingers or other objects into any part of the appliance. Be aware that loose clothing or hair may become trapped in the appliance if improperly used.
- Before use, ensure that all the air vents of the appliance are clear and there is no restriction of air flow.
- Caution: Appliance may disturb ashes in an open fire.
 Always avoid directing the appliance toward naked flames.
- Do not remove the rotor guard once assembled.
- WARNING: Only the power adaptor supplied with the unit can be used with the appliance.

PRODUCT SETUP


1. Remove the air inlet grille by carefully pulling the grille at the bottom.



2. Remove the pre-filter by pressing the raised parts on each side and pulling outward.




3. Remove the filter from its location 4. Reinstall the filter. and remove the protective film from the filter.






5. Reinsert the pre-filter by inserting the slots at the bottom of the pre-filter into the slots in the opening and push the pre-filter into the slots at the top of the opening.



7. Install the power adaptor to the unit



6. Install the air inlet grille by aligning the two upper buckles with the whole in the opening and press tightly. Then press the lower part of air inlet grille at either side to insert the two lower buckles.



NOTE

It is recommended to clean the filter once every two weeks and replace it once every six months. This can be adjusted dependent on environment and usage.

CONTROL AND DISPLAY





Power Button Press to turn the machine on and off.

Mode Press to circulate between Normal, Ionised Air, Sleep and

Smart.

Oscillation Press to start and stop oscillation.

Fan Speed Press to circulate between the fan speeds of 1 to 10.

Timer When the power is on, you can schedule to shut off the

fan, or when in standby mode you can schedule to turn on the fan. To set press the timer button and the display will show 0h, press it again and it will show 1h, continue to press the timer button until the required time is displayed.

Time range is 1 to 12 hours, 0 indicates cancellation.

Filter Reminder When this icon is on and remains on, replace the filter.

Smart mode When this icon is lit, the fan is in Smart mode, and will

automatically adjust in line with changes to the room

temperature. The temperature of the room will be shown.

Sleep mode When this icon is lit, the fan is in Sleep mode. There are 3

levels in sleep mode, 1, 2 and 3, and these can be adjusted

by using the fan speed button.

Number Display This will display the fan speed or the timer setting. In Smart

mode it will display the temperature.

Ionised Air Ionised Air mode.

ADDITIONAL FEATURES

Forced Shutdown

• After 15 hours of continuous operation and without any intervention, the fan will shut down automatically.


Intelligent Memory

• When turning on the fan, it will resume in the last selected mode prior to shutdown (the timing function will not be resumed).

Auto Screen Sleep Mode

• The screen will turn off after 30 seconds of inactivity. In sleep mode, the power button will turn off the fan. Any other button will restore the screen.

REMOTE CONTROL



NOTE The remote should be used within 5m of the front face of the fan.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Replacing the Filter

Filters can be purchased from mda.russellhobbs.com

The below indicator will prompt you to replace the filter. It will remain on at each start up until it is replaced.

Replace the new filter following the instructions for installation in this booklet.

Hold down the mode button for 3 seconds to turn off the filter prompt.











Pre-Filter Cleaning

NOTE Unplug the unit before cleaning.

1. Take out the filter.



2. Remove the dust with a vacuum.



3. Reinsert the pre-filter.



The fan requires little maintenance. Do not try to fix it by yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel if a service is needed.

- Ensure the unit is unplugged before assembly, and before cleaning.
- To ensure adequate air circulation to the motor, keep vents at the rear of the motor free of dust. Do not disassemble the fan to remove dust.
- Please wipe the exterior parts with a soft cloth soaked in a mild detergent.
- Do not use any abrasive detergent or solvents to avoid scratching the surface.
- Do not allow water or any other liquid into the motor housing or interior parts.
- Plastic parts should be cleaned with a soft cloth and mild soap. Thoroughly remove soap film with dry cloth.

| PROBLEM SOLVING | |
|--------------------------------------|---|
| The fan doesn't switch on | Check the fan is plugged in. Check the socket is switched on. Check another appliance in the socket. Unplug and check for any obvious signs of damage to cord or plug. If recently used, allow to cool for 1 hour then try again. |
| The fan is rattling | Check there is nothing in contact with the fan. Check the fan is on a level surface. |
| The remote will not work | The batteries may need replacing. The remote is being used more than 5m away from the product. |
| Fan is making a grinding sound | Immediately switch off and contact Customer Services. |
| The air is dusty | Ensure fan is unplugged and set to OFF. Using a vacuum and crevice brush, gently vacuum the front grille. |

Vacuum the grille at least once every 3 months. The fan may require more frequent vacuuming if in a dusty environment. Ensure that the fan is unplugged before cleaning.
