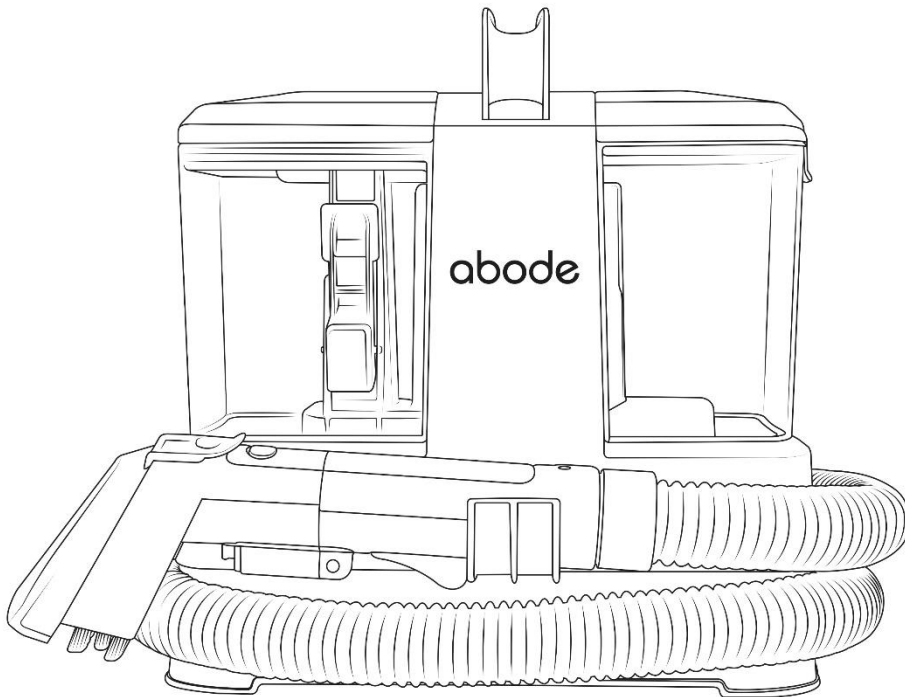

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE USE AND KEEP FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

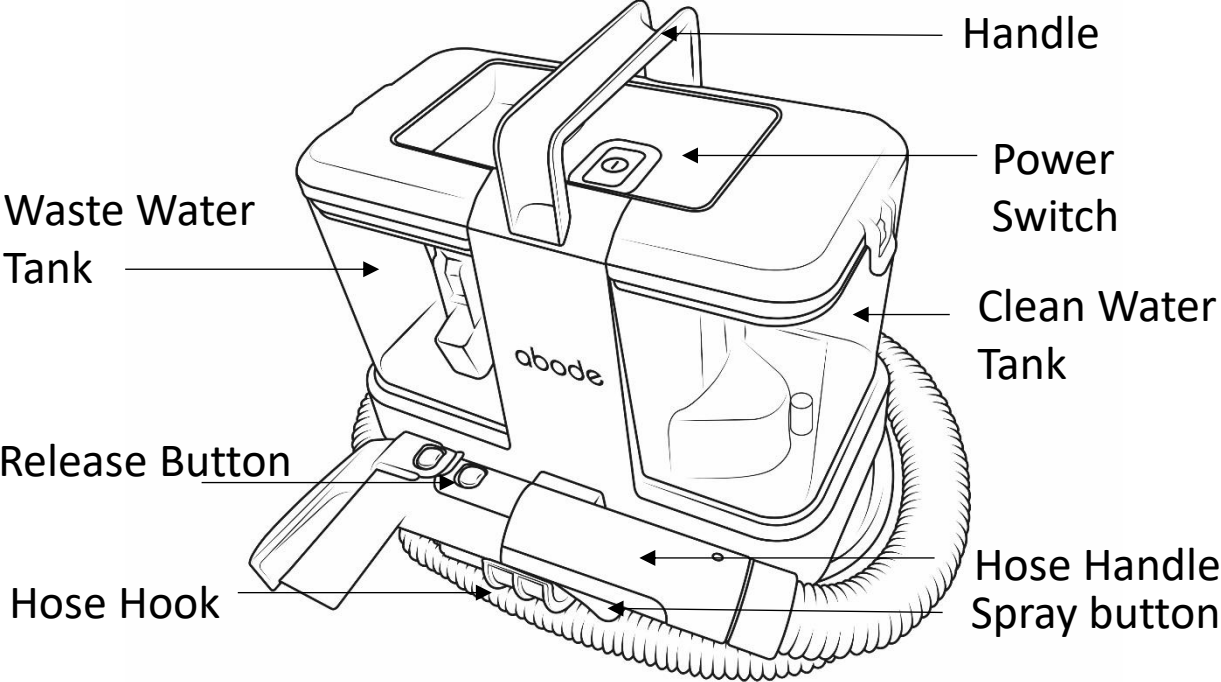
- Do not use solvents that will damage surfaces.

- Use only clean water at 40 degrees Celsius or below.
- If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.
- Young children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.

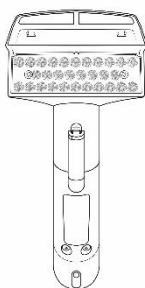

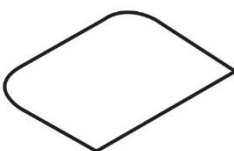

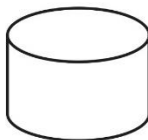

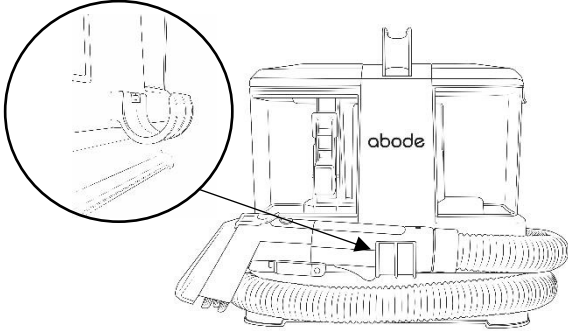

GETTING STARTED

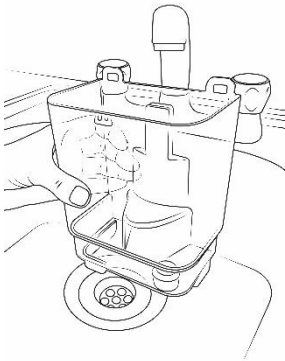
1. Insert the hose hook into place.



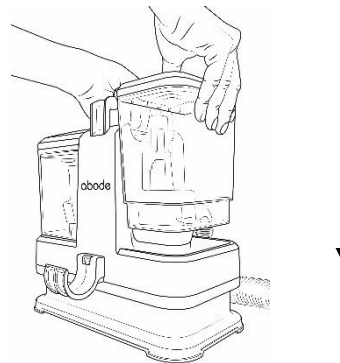
2. Remove clean water tank from machine.



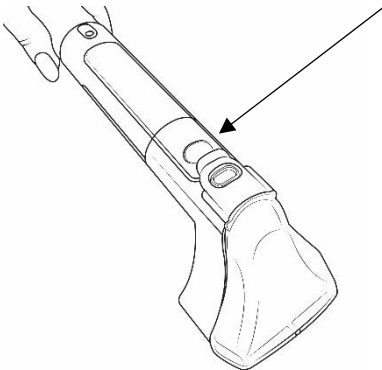
3. Lift top cover of clean water tank off and fill with water to the "max" line. Replace the lid onto the tank and listen for the click!



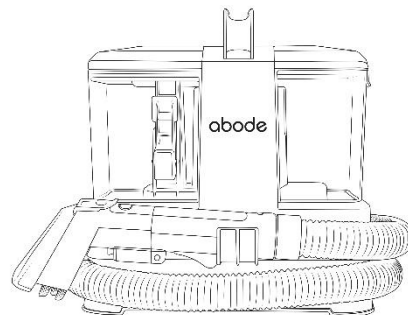
4. Reinstall the clean water tank. Ensure that you do not shake the tank.



5. Fix your chosen accessory into place. Slide the opening on the accessory over the release button.



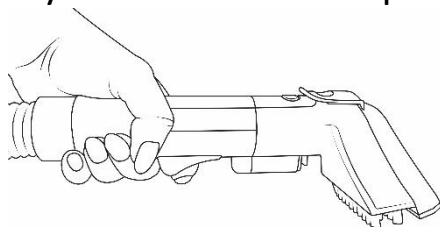
6. Store the wire and hose correctly onto the machine before moving around.



USING YOUR SPOT CLEANER

Operating Instructions

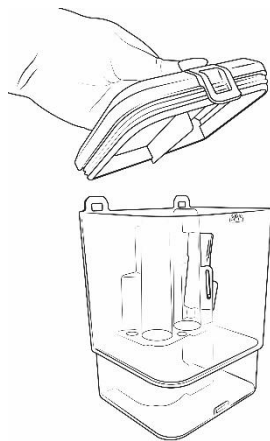
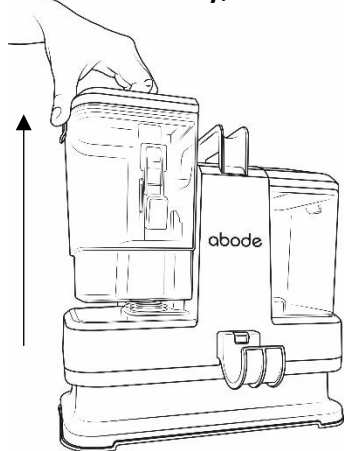
- Insert the plug into the socket and switch on the power.
- Turn the machine on using the power switch.
- Spray clean water onto the area to be cleaned by pressing down the “Spray Button” and then pat with a towel.



- Vacuum the wastewater by releasing the spray button and moving the nozzle over the affected area.
- Turn off the power once finished and unplug the unit.
- Remove and clean both water tanks.
- Remove and clean the sponge filter from the waste-water tank.

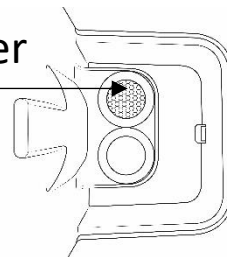
Caution: Avoid shaking the tanks during removal and insertion

- Ensure the waste-water tank is thoroughly cleaned by removing the rubber seal and rinsing this too.
- Once dry, reinsert the rubber seal into the top cover.

Sponge Filter

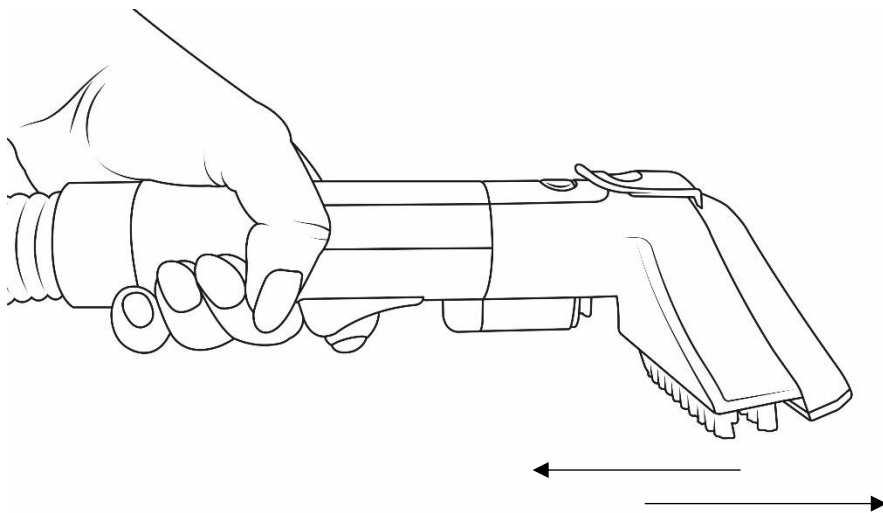


TIPS FOR STUBBORN STAINS

- Apply your choice of appropriate stain remover to the affected area as outlined by the manufacturer's instructions.
- Connect the stubborn stain tool to the hose.
- Fill the clean water tank with warm water – up to 40 degrees Celsius.

Caution: Do not use chloroform, diluents or aniline

- If using a detergent which produces a lot of foam, keep a close eye on the “max” fill level of the waste-water tank and do not exceed this. Foam could enter the unit and cause damage.
- Move the tool back and forward to lift the dirt and detergent.

As the colours of the wires in the mains lead of this appliance may not correspond with the coloured markings identifying the terminals in your plug, proceed as follows:

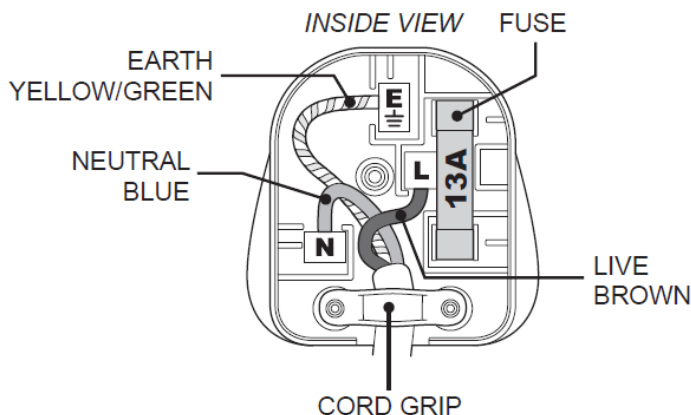
The GREEN/YELLOW wire is the EARTH and must be connected to the terminal which is marked with the letter E or by the earth symbol or coloured GREEN or GREEN/YELLOW.

The BLUE wire is the NEUTRAL and must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter N or coloured BLACK.


The BROWN wire is the LIVE wire and must be connected to the terminal marked with the letter L or coloured RED.

Always ensure that the plug cord grip is fastened correctly.


If a 13A (BS1363) fused plug is used it must be fitted with a 13amp fuse conforming to BS1362 and be BSI or ASTA approved.

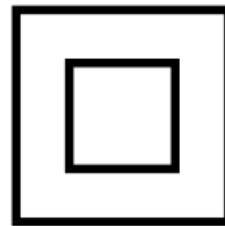
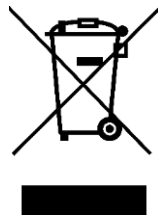
